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THE PROVINCE OF HUELVA ENJOYS A STRATEGIC GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION, MAKING IT THE IDEAL PLACE TO BASE YOUR BUSINESS

Its location makes Huelva the backbone between Europe, Africa and America, and places it as a focus of investment and referral logistics centre for more than 500 million of foreign consumers.

Its communication and access network through Huelva's port, the international airports of Seville and Faro (Portugal), the direct, high-speed railway line to Madrid (AVE) and the connection to the TEN-T (Trans-European Transport Networks) Core Network makes it the most privileged location to compete in a global market.

Huelva is well-known as the Costa de la Luz (Coast of Light) due to its more than 3,000 hours of sunshine per year and 120 km of coast, two qualities that give it a unique appeal for it to produce high-quality products with Designation of Origin. Not for nothing it has recently been declared as the Spanish Capital City of Gastronomy 2017.

Being a part of Huelva is living in a province able to make the industry a powerful driving force and bet on the right investment.

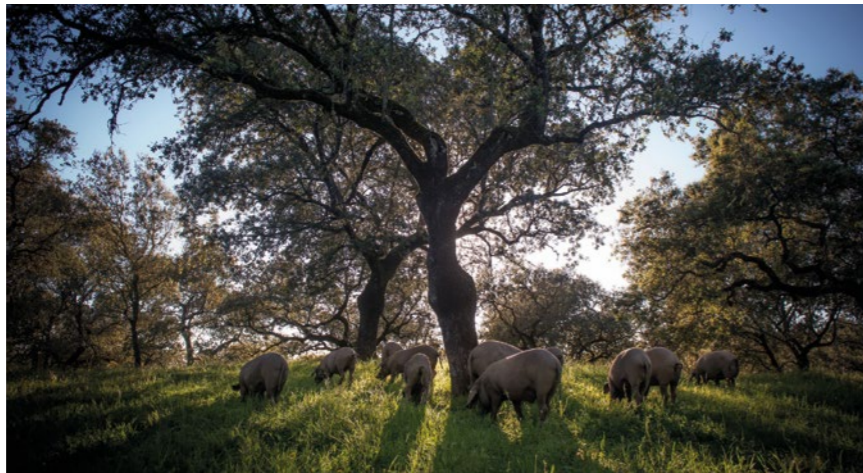

The mountain range of Huelva is home to the largest number of meat companies. Municipalities located in Sierra de Aracena and Picos de Aroche Natural Park, with meadows and pastures that has been designated as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO.

Some towns and municipalities, such as Jabugo, spearhead the Designation of Origin, thus turning the meat sector into a national and international benchmark.

Currently there are over 140 companies in the meat industry in Huelva, directly employing more than 1,200 people.

Many leading companies, such as *El Pozo*, *Grupo Dompall* or *Vall Company* contribute to boost the development of local industry, as well as the job creation in this sector.



The headquarters of the **CIPCI** (Iberian Pork and Protected Designation of Origin Innovation and Promotion Centre) is located in the Tiro Pichón building, in Jabugo, designed by the architect Aníbal González.
